

## **HÖHN impresses expert jury with measures to resource and energy saving measures**

### **Martin Höhn GmbH, based in Rosenfeld, is one of seven companies in Baden-Württemberg to be awarded the ReTech-BW funding program**

With the ReTech-BW program, the Ministry of the Environment promotes measures in manufacturing companies that contribute to climate protection - by increasing resource and energy efficiency, improving the securing and supply of raw materials or conserving natural resources.

The funding programme is implemented as a joint measure of the Ministry of the Environment, Climate Protection and the Energy Sector Baden-Württemberg, with organizational support from the Project Management Agency Karlsruhe (PTKA) and technical support from Umwelttechnik BW GmbH.

#### **1.1 million euros for exemplary and innovative solutions**

A total of 1.1 million euros is available from the state's "Zukunftsland BW - Stärker aus der Krise" package of measures. The applications received will be evaluated by an expert jury chaired by the Baden-Württemberg Ministry of the Environment, Climate Protection and the Energy Sector.

"With ReTech-BW, we are supporting exemplary and innovative solutions that lead to significant increases in efficiency. The aim of this low-threshold funding is to also enable short-term implementation," emphasizes State Environment Minister Thekla Walker.

#### **Globally unique process minimizes rejects**

The manual solution and calibration of spherical plain bearings, currently the state of the art in production, cannot be achieved without rejects. Martin Höhn GmbH is investing the funding in a robot-assisted assembly system that will produce consistently good results using an automated process. This will reduce rejects to a minimum. The process for the automated and sensor-based loosening of spherical plain bearings is unique in the world.
